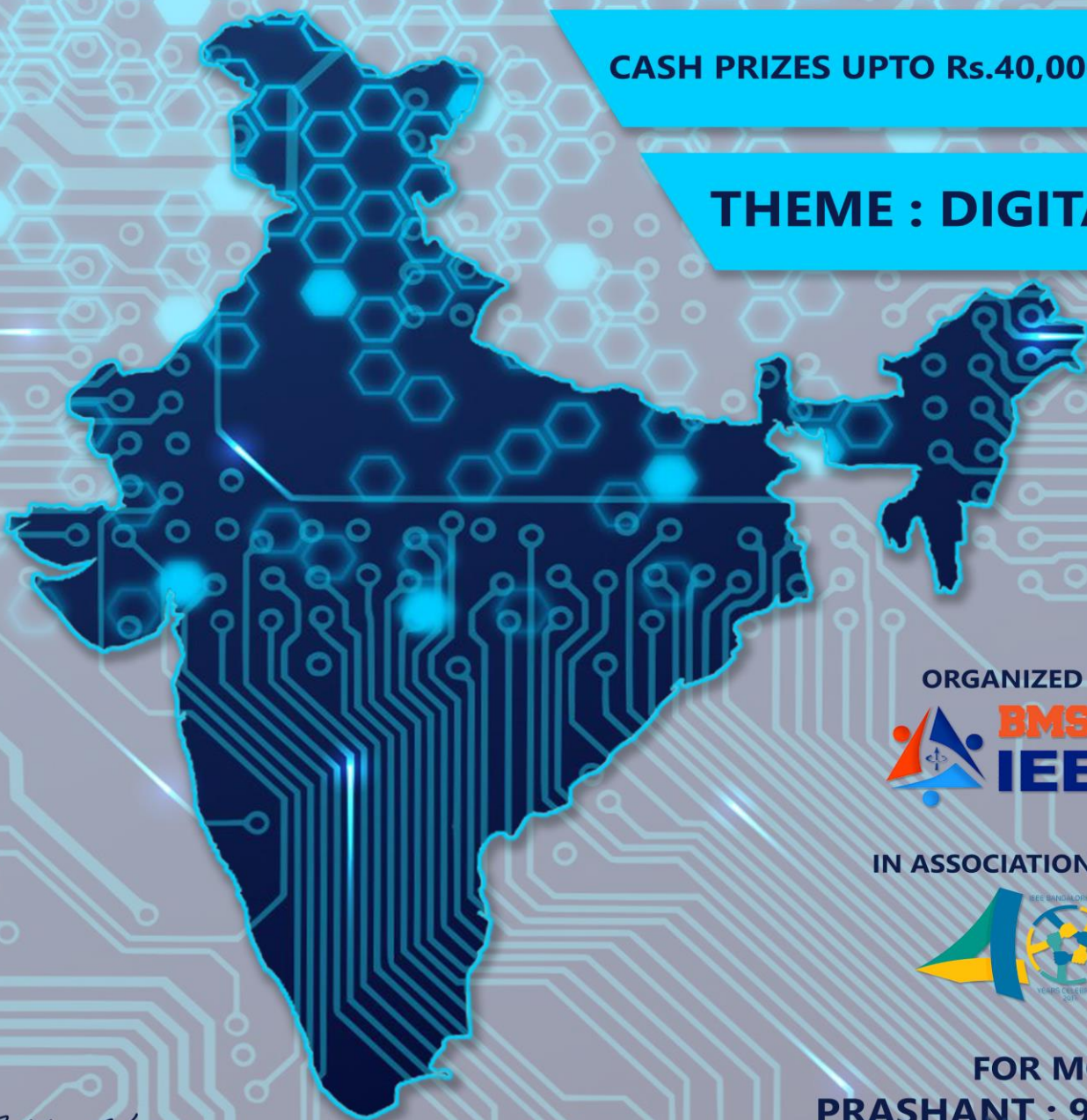

YINAC 2017 Rulebook and Guidelines

Participation Criteria & Rules

- The team can have an individual to a **maximum of 4 members and minimum 1 member**.
- **At least half** of the members of each team must be IEEE Members.
- All the members of the team should be a student of a Registered Educational Institute in India and be **graduating in 2018 or later**. The contest is not open to individuals who will graduate in the year 2017 or earlier.
- All the members of the team should be **enrolled only in an engineering course at the undergraduate level**. No postgraduate students (M.E/M.Tech/M.Sc/Doctorate) are allowed.
- Any project which is already a part of another grant/approval is not eligible.
- No endorsement of college is needed.
- A student **cannot be a member of multiple teams**.
- Teams are allowed to **submit only one project entry**.
- Finalists will present their project at BMSCE, Bangalore in August 2017 where winners will be announced. The dates will be informed a week before.
- BMSCE IEEE processes the personal data of the members of the teams that has been collected in connection with the participants' application. This data is used only for the purposes of the competition and for reasonable marketing communications.
- The following will be the prizes:
 - a. 1st Prize: Rs. 15000/-
 - b. 2nd Prize: Rs. 10000/-
 - c. 3rd Prize: Rs. 5000/-
- Any decision for which the rules have not been mentioned, will be at the discretion.
- **The IP Rights of the product developed stays with the participants.**

Contest Stages & Description

Step 1) Abstract Submission (Deadline: June 10th, 2017)

Form a team of maximum 4 students and submit the abstract of your project. A committee comprising representatives from IEEE Bangalore Section will short-list abstracts based on the relevance of problem identified and ingenuity of the solution proposed.

Step 2) Announcement of short-listed Projects (June 15th, 2017)

Once you are short-listed, you will be notified via email. Once, you receive the notification, you can start working on the project. You will have approximately two months for the development, i.e. June(half), July and August(half).

Step 3) Notification for Presentation (In August 3rd Week)

Two months after the beginning of the development, we will notify you of the dates when you need to present your project to a panel of judges where you will be judged.

Step 4) Presentation (As per the notified date)

On this day, you will present your project to a panel of judges from the IEEE Bangalore Section according to a given template where you will be judged on the following criteria:

- a. Genuineness of the idea or Innovativeness
- b. Technical Work
- c. Market Potential

The winners will be awarded the prize money and the event will come to an end with the lunch.
